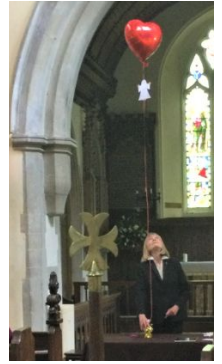


Religious Life of our school

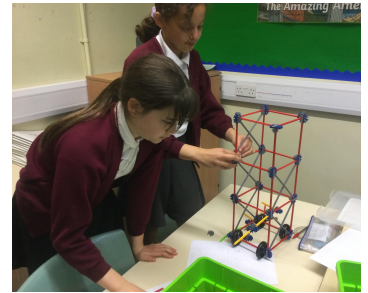
