09/12/20	School Christmas lunch	Each class will have their usual festive Christmas lunch with crackers and chocolate treats. This will be organised within their bubble.

w/beginning 14/12/20	Christmas Presentation shared with parents	In the last week of term, the Christmas presentations will be shared with all parents and families. A text will be sent to inform of the release.
11/12/20	Christmas jumper day	This is in support of Save the Children charity. Children are invited to wear a festive jumper, with the rest of their school uniform. Suggested donations of £1 will be collected by each School Council Rep.
