Create a model of a Viking longboat that can float

Design a Viking board game. How many players can play? What is the purpose of the game and how do you win?

Write a message in Viking runes.

Research and write a fact file about two different Viking gods



Draw or print out a picture of yourself and a Viking child. Write about the similarities and differences between you both. Include information about their day, school, family, toys, pets, work.

Research the Yorvik centre in York. Write key information about it.

Create a timeline of key events that happened between the start of the Anglo-Saxon era and the end of the Vikings.

Create an interesting collage of a Viking scene; stormy sea, long boat, a raid!
