Science - Forces and Magnets	Music	Computing				
Our focus in Science lessons is ‘Forces and Magnets.’ The Children will explore different forces, learn about friction, test whether materials are magnetic or not, use the words ‘attract’ and ‘repel,’ and carry out experiments relating to forces and magnets.	Mrs Cresswell will be teaching year 3 and 4 music every 2 weeks on a Tuesday afternoon. She will be using the ‘ <b>Sing Up</b> ’ program and this half term’s unit is called ‘I’ve Been to Harlem.’	The children will begin the year learning about Computing Systems, Networks and the Internet. This will include an e-safety theme.				
PE	Art - Drawing	History - The Roman Empire				
The children will have 2 P.E. lessons a week. One lesson will be taught by a specialist coach from Saracens who will be teaching hockey skills. The second lesson will be taught by the class teacher and will have a focus on circuit training and personal fitness.	We will be using the work of Vincent Van Gogh to inspire us in our unit of work on drawing skills. The children will experiment with showing line, tone and texture with different hardness of pencils; use shading to show light and shadow effects; use different materials to draw, e.g. pastels, chalk, felt tip and show an awareness of space/perspective when drawing.	In this unit, the children will learn what it was like to live in Britain before the Romans arrived, how Britain became part of the Roman Empire and how Britain changed as a result of Roman settlement.
