






English	Maths	RE				
<p>In English this half term, we will be focussing on 2 main texts: <i>The Thames and Tide Club</i> by Katya Balen and <i>The Story of Tutankhamun</i> by Patricia Cleveland-Peck.</p>  <p>We will use the texts to write posters, descriptions, letters, diaries, instructions, newspaper reports and dialogue.</p>	<p>In Maths, we will be learning about the following areas:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Time (telling the time to 5 minutes, using a.m. and p.m, converting between analogue and digital time, using 12 and 24 hour clocks and using years, months, weeks and days.) • Decimals (using tenths and hundredths, halves and quarters, rounding to the nearest whole number and dividing by 10 and 100) • Money (using pounds and pence, writing money as decimals, comparing and estimating amounts of money, adding and subtracting money and finding change. 	<p>Religion focus: Christianity Our enquiry question this half term is: What difference did Paul's conversion on the Damascus Road make to Christians?</p>
