

How to print worksheets from the Oak National Academy

Set out below is a step-by-step guide to printing these worksheets from the Oak National Academy website.

Printing from a Chromebook or laptop


Step One:

Please ensure that you have Chrome installed on your device (laptop, Chromebook, iPad or similar) This looks like this:



Step Two:

Before you go to the Oak National Academy website and start your lesson, sign in to the browser. When you open the browser, you may find that you get the following page:




Sign in with your Google Account.

Step Three:

Now that you have signed in, go to the worksheet section of the Oak National Academy website.

Step Four:

Go to www.drive.google.com and click on 'Shared with me'.

Click on the Google Slide for the lesson to open it.


