Trip to Cliveden : Tuesday, 20th June

Our whole school trip to the gardens of the Cliveden House, a National Trust property, is planned for Tuesday, 20th June, during 'Our Small Church School' week. During this visit, the children will be able to visit the maze, enjoy outdoor games and share a picnic together. This trip will also provide the children with inspiration for the redesign of the school garden, which is a project that they will be focussing on during this week.

For this trip, it is essential that all children wear full school uniform. If they have black trainers, they are encouraged to wear these for practical reasons.

All Nursery children are very welcome to stay for the whole day, so that they can also be part of this trip. We are due to return before the end of the school day.
