<p>The children will continue to learn and use new vocabulary linked to our topic. They will continue to listen carefully to other people and will learn to ask questions. They will be encouraged to speak in full sentences, using a range of tenses correctly. They will practise aiming using equipment to prepare for Sports Day. <p>The children will be consolidating their number knowledge counting to 20 and recognising the pattern of teen numbers. Practise of number bonds to 5 and some bonds to 10. Using First, Then, Now to work out simple addition and subtraction within 10. They will use their knowledge of doubling to support learning on halving, grouping and sharing.</p>	 	<p>The children will continue to have Little Wandle daily phonics and reading sessions. The children will continue to explore non fiction books and enjoy a range of fiction linked to holiday locations. The children will identify characters' feelings in stories read to them and give reasons for these feelings. They will develop their writing stamina when writing labels, captions and sentences. They will continue to develop their letter formation and be encouraged to use an appropriate size when writing. They will write packing lists, postcards and letters from holiday destinations.</p>
Understanding of the World		Expressive Arts & Design
<p>The children will learn some facts about minibeasts and sort according to features. They will identify changes associated with summer. How to stay safe in the sun and in the sea. They will learn how to keep our bodies healthy. Focus on different environments when discussing holidays. Identify on a world map. The children will have the opportunity to look at holiday brochures and photographs as well as share personal experiences to aid discussions and enable comparisons. In RE, children will 'How can we care for our wonderful World' which lays foundations for understanding that Christians believe humans are a special part of God's creation and have God-given responsibility to care for the incredible world we all share.</p>		<p>The children will create minibeast related artwork. To keep a steady beat. To make a musical instrument (rain sticks) To create artwork and 3D model creations using different joining techniques including using tabs and including making sunglasses and tents.
