# Spotlight on learning

In Year 5 & 6, we have been reading and enjoying the gothic story –Wind in the Walls. We have been exploring the conventions and language used in the gothic genre and the children are now working towards creating their very own gothic horror story.


During our geography lessons, Yr 5 and 6 have been researching information on different biomes. They have made their own posters and even created their own mini rainforest biome in a bottle!







Calm descends upon the class during our weekly PE lesson where they are learning different yoga positions and then creating their own Yoga Flows.



In Science we have started our new topic of Earth and Space.

We have looked at the movements of the Earth, Moon, and Sun, including making a model using split pins of the Earth and Moon's rotation and revolution.

The children have also researched this and made notes using lots of scientific vocabulary.

We have learned about what causes us to have night and day and used a torch and globe to investigate this during lesson.

We have also looked at what causes the seasons and researched the characteristics of each season and how these are caused by the Earth's tilt.

During Design and Technology, Year 5 and 6 have been learning about the seasonality of different foods and considering the benefits of producing and buying various foods locally and in season. We also spent the afternoon tasting a variety of soups including; Thai green vegetable, lentil and smoked bacon, and Caribbean sweet potato (which was the overall favourite!)
