We will also read 'Ocean Meets Sky' by Eric Fan & Terry Fan, building on our narrative writing skills and writing our own fantasy world narratives.</p>	<p>Religion or World View Focus: Christianity Our enquiry question this half term is: Why do Christians trust Jesus and follow him?</p>				
Science	Computing					
<p>Our Science topic this half term is survival. We will explore the main animal groups and learn what different animals need in order to survive. We will experiment by creating a shelter for a chosen animal and test how secure it is. We will focus on birds and discover how some are flightless and some can swim. The children will carry out a bird watch in the school grounds and collect data about the different types of birds we see in our local environment.</p>		<p>In our Computing lessons, we will focus on programming algorithms. We will be able to give instructions to create an algorithm, create a sequence, predict the outcome of a sequence and use this to plan a route. We will also test our algorithms and debug simple errors within them.</p>

<p>During PE lessons, the children will begin athletics activities in preparation for Sports Day. There will be a focus on agility, running, jumping and throwing. We will also practise our skipping skills - a great one to try at home if you haven't already. Please ensure children have their PE kit in school for the whole week, as we tend to make the most of the good weather and get outside when we can!</p>	<p>In Art this half term, we will be creating collages linked to our Geography topic, the weather. Our focus artist for this unit is Katsushikika Hokusai. We will look at his artwork before creating our own by selecting and using a variety of shapes, materials, colours, tones and textures. We will also layer this to create a range of effects within our work.</p>	<p>This half term for our topic lessons, we will be exploring different types of weather. We will plan what clothing is needed for a warm, Summers day and create a weather forecast for the UK. We will also explore extreme weather like storms, blizzards and draughts and talk about what the weather is like in different parts of the world.</p>
