In today's rapidly evolving digital landscape, keeping our children safe online requires a strong partnership between school and home. While we continue to embed digital citizenship and online safety in our curriculum, we recognise that most challenges occur outside school hours.

During this interactive session, you will gain valuable insights into:

- Current Digital Trends and Platforms Learn about the latest apps, games, and social media platforms your children may be using, including both the opportunities they offer and potential risks to be aware of, including AI.
- New Online Safety Legislation Understand the recent changes in online safety laws and age verification requirements that affect your children's digital activities, and how these can support your family's online safety decisions.
- Practical Protection Strategies Discover effective ways to set up parental controls across different devices and platforms, along with tips for having productive conversations with your children about responsible internet use.
- The SmartPhone Free Childhood Movement Explore this growing initiative and learn about alternative approaches to technology use that many families are adopting, along with research on the impacts of smartphone use on child development. The session will include time for questions and discussion, allowing you to address your specific concerns and share experiences with other parents. We will also provide links to all the resources shown with practical guides and useful links for future reference.
