# Harvest Service


You show your care for the land by sending rain; you make it rich and fertile.



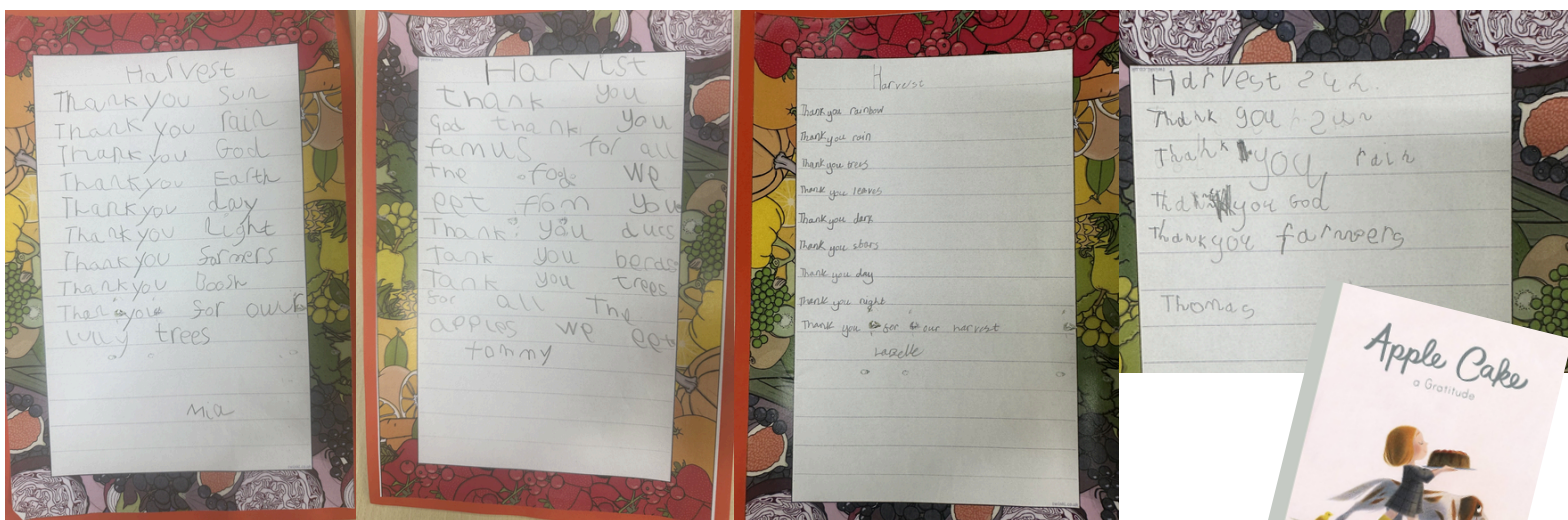
