

<p>This half term we are learning about Animals including Humans. Throughout this topic we will look at how humans grow and develop, and explore key milestones in baby and child development. We will look at understanding puberty as the process of changing from a child to an adult, and explore the key changes that happen to humans in adulthood and late adulthood. We will also be comparing the gestation periods of different mammals.</p>	<p>Mrs Cresswell will be teaching Year 5 and 6 music every 2 weeks on a Tuesday afternoon. She will be using the 'Sing Up' program and this half term's unit is called Building a groove Época. As part of this unit, the children will learn simple song writing.</p>	<p>In Computing, we will be looking at Introduction to Spreadsheets. We will identify questions which can be answered using data and explain that objects can be described using data. We will explore how formulas can be used to produce calculated data and apply formulas to data, including duplicating. We will create a spreadsheet to plan an event and choose suitable ways to present data.</p>
