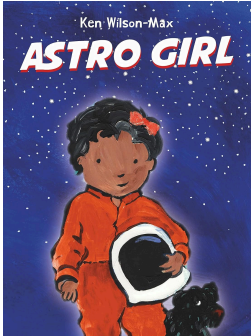
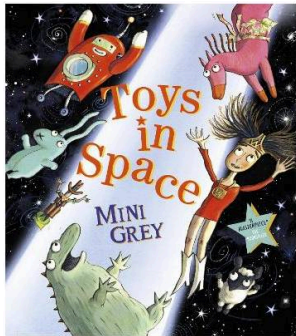


Maths	English	RE
